#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Certification Board supervises seven (7) drinking water professional certification areas with twenty (20) distinct examinations [including grade levels within the seven (7) programs]. Changes across the industry and improvement efforts within the Section are challenges being addressed.

#### **Background:**

The Certification Committee has been involved in the following activities:

- The Certification Board Policy Manual was finalized for Board action; it was distributed to this Board on September, 14, 2018, by Tim Worley for review and comment and is addressed separately in this Board Packet
- Coordination with the Section Policy Manual update process continues
- Ongoing operations of each certification offering continues as planned for 2018
- Partnership with the California Water Environment Association (CWEA) on the Advanced Water Treatment Operator certification program continues and is addressed later in this Board Packet
- The Association Boards of Certification (ABC) seeks to collaborate by reselling our Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester certification exam to their clients and is addressed later in this Board Packet
- The Alliance for Water Efficiency (AWE) seeks to collaborate with us to promote the Water Use Efficiency Practitioner program across the nation
- The CA Employment Development Department (EDD) determination that our Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester certification exam proctors were employees instead of independent contractors; this required a labor intensive activity by the Section to expedite employment documents.
